



TOWN OFFICE DECLARATION OF CANDIDACY BY A DEMOCRATIC, LIBERTARIAN, OR REPUBLICAN PARTY CANDIDATE WHEN NO TOWN PRIMARY IS CONDUCTED IN 2023

INSTRUCTIONS: This form must be filed with the circuit court clerk of the county in which most of the town's population is located not earlier than **January 4, 2023** and not later than **NOON, August 1, 2023** before an election. **This form is to be used by a Democratic Party, Libertarian Party, or Republican Party candidate for a town office in a town that has a population of less than 3,500 in which no town primary will be conducted.** A candidate of any other political party *(or an independent candidate)* must use the CAN-45 and CAN-44 forms in 2023. A write-in candidate for town office must use the CAN-51 form in 2023.

The candidate's name must comply with the requirements in Indiana Code 3-5-7. If a candidate's name does not comply with this state law, the declaration may be challenged under Indiana Code 3-8-1-2. A candidate may use a nickname on the ballot only if the nickname is a name by which the candidate is commonly known and does not exceed 20 characters. A candidate may not use a title or degree as a designation or a designation that implies a title or degree. Nicknames are required to be printed on the ballot using parentheses. EXAMPLE: John R. (Jack) Doe

CAMPAIGN FINANCE NOTICE

If required to open a candidate's committee pursuant to Indiana's Campaign Finance Act, a candidate's committee must file a pre-election campaign finance report no later than NOON (prevailing local time), October 20, 2023, with the appropriate county election board.

The candidate's committee must also file a pre-election supplemental report no later than forty-eight (48) hours after the committee receives contributions from a person that total \$1,000 or more during the period beginning October 14, 2023 and ending at 6 a.m. (prevailing local time) on November 5, 2023, with the appropriate county election board. If no such contribution is received, the candidate's committee is not required to file a supplemental report.

A person who fails to file a report with the county election board is subject to a civil penalty of \$50 for each calendar day the report is late, with the afternoon of the final date for filing the report being calculated as the first day, for a maximum penalty of not more than \$1,000, plus any investigative costs incurred and documented by the county election board.
