
Whitley County Sheriff's Department

If you are the successful bidder, all sales are full payment, due the date of sale, payable by cashier's check or money order, immediately following the sale. In order to place a bid, you will need to bring with you a letter from your bank or financial institution that you have a specified amount of money available to you within a 1-2 hour timeframe. This amount will be the maximum amount you will be allowed to bid.

Judgment amounts are listed below. The judgment amount is NOT a bid, just the amount the Court has awarded the Plaintiff as owed. The Plaintiff (the bank foreclosing on the property) may bid whatever they want, sometimes this can be considerably less than the judgment amount. The Plaintiff may also bid considerably more than the judgment, an example of why this would be is if they are attempting to recover additional costs, attorney fees, additional interest, etc.
