Legend

- CFOs, active 2016
- 1320' distance from existing CFOs
- 1320' from existing subdivisions of 3 lots or more
- 660' distance around house address points
- 300' distance from open drains

Notes:

- Address buffers around address points listed as houses. Points are placed typically where driveway enters the road. As proposed, the code would measure from the structure itself, and would include all residences. Thus, this illustrates the density of houses, though not the exact locations.
- All types of subdivisions of 3 lots or more are shown, not just residential. Residential is most common type of subdivision.
