### TAX ABATEMENT REQUEST


Mr. Myers presented a request for a 10-year real property tax abatement for a business expansion in a new building to be located in Park 30. The orthopedics business is already located in Whitley County but must move from its current space to a new location to provide room for growth. The new building would be approximately 16,500 sq. ft., with room for expansion by another 8,000 sq. ft. 22 new jobs would be created, in addition to retaining the current 24 employees. After a brief discussion, Mr. Wheeler made a motion to recommend a favorable pass to the County Council; Mr. Schrader seconded. The motion passed 5-0.

There being no further business, Mr. Argerbright declared the meeting adjourned at 7:43 a.m.
