**ORDER ESTABLISHING
RULES OF PROBATION**

The above named juvenile, having been adjudicated a delinquent child on the ____ day of _____, 2009, it is Now ORDERED that _____ be committed to _____, said commitment being suspended and the juvenile is placed on probation for a period of ____ months, with the following terms and conditions of probation:

- _____ 1. You shall not commit a delinquent act as defined by I.C. 31-37-1-1 or violate any state or federal law or local ordinance, and shall not be in the presence of someone who is violating the law or committing a delinquent act.
- _____ 2. You shall contact the Bowen Center or other: _____, within 24 hours of this order, for substance abuse and/or mental health counseling and comply with all recommendations of said facility, all at the cost of the juvenile or his/her parent or guardian. Furthermore, you shall execute a written Release of Information permitting the release of counseling records to the Probation Department.
- _____ 3. You shall contact the Community Corrections Department and arrange for the completion of the Youth Improvement Center Program. The juvenile shall comply with all rules established by Community Corrections or its agents and shall be responsible, together with his/her parent or guardian, to pay the cost of said program. The administrator of the Youth Improvement Center is authorized to file a Youth Improvement Center rule violation directly with the Court and schedule a hearing with the Court at which you and your parents will be ordered to appear.
- _____ 4. You shall contact the Community Corrections Department this date and arrange for the completion of ____ days of community service. You shall comply will all rules established by Community Corrections or its agents.
- _____ 5. You shall serve ____ days on home detention and shall contact the Community Corrections Department this date to arrange for the completion of the same. You shall comply with all rules established by Community Corrections or its agents. The home detention officer is authorized to file a home detention rule violation directly with the Court and schedule a hearing with the Court at which you and your parents will be ordered to appear.
- _____ 6. You shall apologize to the victim as arranged by the Probation Department and initiate no contact with the victim.

- _____ 7. You shall have no social contact with anyone on Probation and _____.
- _____ 8. You shall attend school, complete all class assignments as required by teachers, comply with all rules established by the school, and execute a Release of Information to allow the Probation Department to obtain information from the school regarding you.
- _____ 9. You shall maintain your employment. If unemployed, you shall seek employment and shall provide the Probation Department (weekly) with the names and addresses of five employers to whom you have applied for employment.
- _____ 10. You shall consent to and provide a bodily substance required for alcohol and/or drug testing as requested by the Whitley County Probation Department or any law enforcement officer. A failure, refusal, or tampering with the sample is a violation of probation.
- _____ 11. You shall permit your probation officer to visit you at reasonable times at your home, school, work, or elsewhere, and shall report to your probation officer when requested.
- _____ 12. You shall be on a **HOME** curfew of _____ P.M. (You shall be in your home at this time until 6:00 A.M. daily) or be with a responsible person, with prior consent of your probation officer, for times beyond the curfew. If you are employed and are scheduled to work after your curfew, your work schedule must be approved by your probation officer.
- _____ 13. You and your parents shall pay restitution in the amount of \$_____. Payments shall be made on a schedule established by the Whitley County Prosecutor's Victim Assistance Advocate.
- _____ 14. You shall not possess any firearms (including BB guns, paintball guns or airsoft guns), ammunition, destructive devices, knives or deadly weapons.
- _____ 15. You shall waive your right to search and seizure and permit your probation officer, or any law enforcement officer acting on the probation officer's behalf, to search you, your residence, motor vehicle, or any location where your personal property may be found, to ensure compliance with probation.
- _____ 16. You shall notify your probation officer within 48 hours of any change in employment, residence, or telephone number, and/or any contact with law enforcement officer, or discipline action taken against you by school officials.
- _____ 17. You shall not operate a motor vehicle for _____ days, and shall immediately surrender your driver's license to your probation officer.
- _____ 18. You shall not possess or use a cellular phone for _____ days, and shall immediately surrender your cellular phone to your probation officer.
- _____ 19. You shall not travel outside the State of Indiana without prior approval from your probation officer.

- _____ 20. You shall not possess, purchase or use tobacco products or possess paraphernalia. All items will be confiscated and **NOT** returned.
- _____ 21. You shall serve _____ days in a secure detention facility or (shelter care facility).
- _____ 22. You shall assist your parents in the payment of all Probation, Community Corrections, and related fees if you are financially able to do so.
