

## WHITLEY COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

The Whitley County Commissioners met in special session at 2:00 pm on Thursday, September 7, 2017 in the Commissioner's Room located on the first floor of the Whitley County Government Center. Commissioners in attendance were Chairman George Schrumpf, Vice Chairman Don and Commissioner Thomas Western. Chairman Schrumpf called the meeting to order and led the group in the Pledge of Allegiance.


**IN THE MATTER OF BID OPENING FOR THE JAIL CHILLER:** The Commissioners opened the sealed bids for the Jail Chiller. The first bid was from Wein Shearer Mechanical for \$212,351.00. The second bid was from Shambaugh and Sons for \$201,607.00 and the third bid was from PDP for \$207,540.00. Commissioner Schrumpf stated that the Commissioners would review the bids and take them under advisement. They will award the bid for the jail chiller at the next Commissioner meeting on September 18, 2017.


**IN OTHER BUSINESS:** Commissioner Amber stated that the County has had several project needs to building improvements. He asked the other Commissioners and Mark Sturtevant how they felt about having a bond for all the projects rather than doing each project individually. He would also like to see the County purchase the land beside the Community Corrections building. The Commissioners asked Mark to find out what the needs are for maintenance in the next five to ten years.

There being no further business and no further questions or comments from the public, Chairman Schrumpf adjourned the meeting at 2:30 PM.
